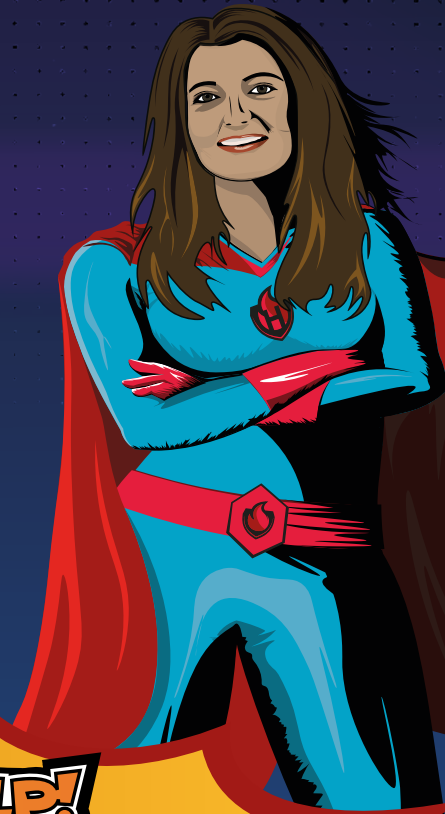

One of the Coldemorts has 6 differences from the other. See if you can spot them all to help our Heroes work out which is the real one!



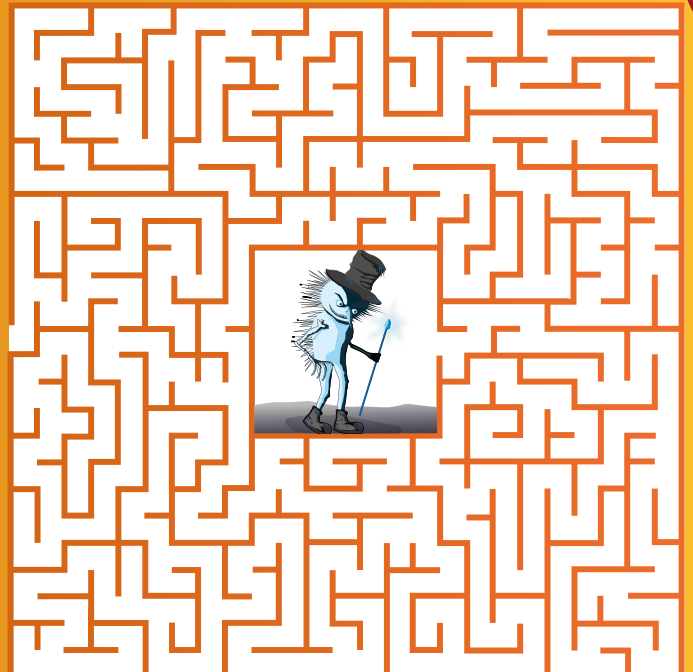
HEAT NEEDS YOUR HELP!

Coldemort is planning more sneaky schemes but he's gone into hiding and our heroes can't find him.

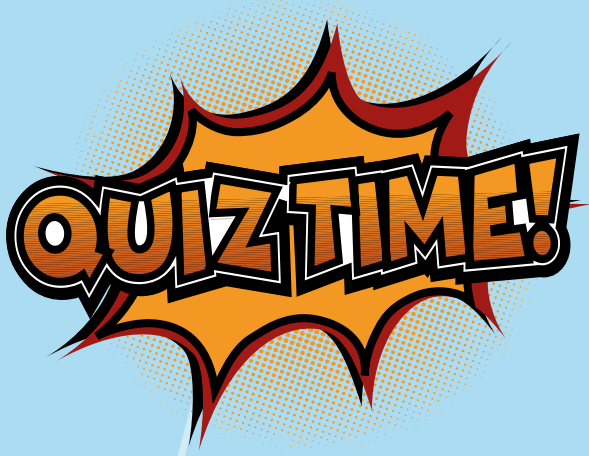

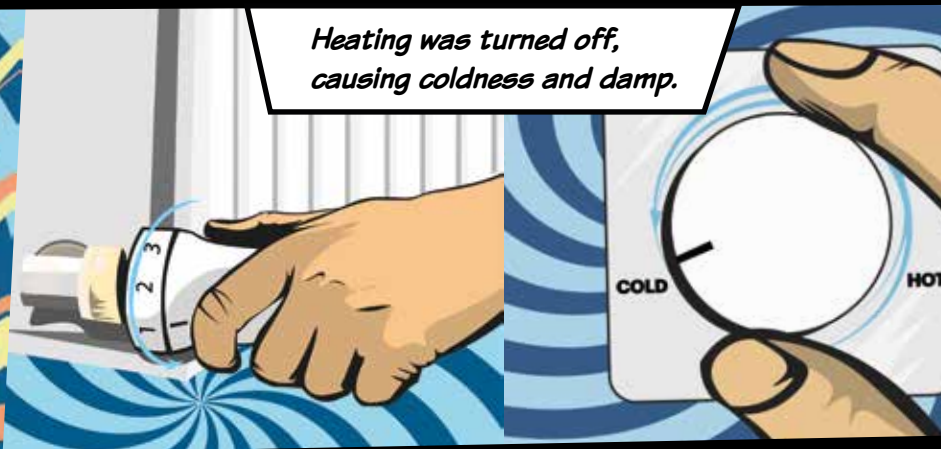


One by one, people began to be brainwashed by Coldemort's villainous crystal...

Well, that's the end of Coldemort's evil plans for now, but i'm sure we'll see him again before long with a dastardly new scheme.

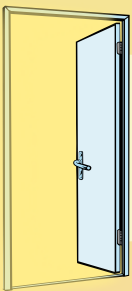
BE AN ENERGY-SAVING SUPERHERO TO HELP BEAT COLDEMORT!

Grab your cape - it's time for you to be a **HEAT Hero** too!

Each of these energy-saving top tips will let you tap into your own superhero powers to help beat Coldemort!

Next to each tip, you'll see Impact Points - this is how super-effective it is at saving energy and beating Coldemort.

Try to get at least **30 Impact Points** each day to keep Coldemort at bay!



Close doors as soon as you can when you leave a room or leave the house. This stops the heat escaping and keeps the cold from creeping in!

If you start to feel a little bit cold, putting on a jumper or getting a blanket rather than turning the heating up can save lots of energy and money. Plus a blanket goes great with a film and popcorn!

points



Remember to turn games consoles and TVs off fully when you aren't using them. If they are on standby or sleep mode, they are still using lots of energy! You can switch them off, then turn them off at the wall to be sure.

It also takes a lot of energy to heat water, so make sure you don't keep the hot tap running when brushing your teeth. Try to take quicker showers and aim for less than 5 minutes. A good tip is to play two of your favourite songs and try to be finished before the second song ends!

Switching off lights is easy and it helps save energy, so remember to turn them off whenever they aren't needed.
